Report on SSIP awareness seminar series for the students

Date: 13th & 14th July 2017

With the view to promote and support the initiatives by young entrepreneurs, innovators and start-ups through the education, Government of Gujarat is implementing student start-up and innovation policy (SSIP) 2017-2021 for enhancing Innovation and Pre-incubation Ecosystem Support for Students (IPIES).
